### **SUMMER TRANSIENT APPLICANT:**

#### **Definition** -

An applicant with a high school diploma (with the exception of a high school concurrent enrollment participant) who wishes to take specific undergraduate coursework *for Summer only,* and does *not* wish to pursue a degree at Texas A&M University.

Application Dates/Deadline for Summer Term Only 2021

Opening Jan. 1, 2021 Closing April 1, 2021

# **Documents Needed/**Required Credentials

## All materials must be received BY THE APPLICATION DEADLINE.

- State of Texas ApplyTexas Application Completed. <u>www.applytexas.org.</u> Please select the <u>Transient</u> Application when applying online.
- Nonrefundable Processing Fee \$75 if a domestic applicant. Credit Card payments may be charged a minimal, nonrefundable transaction fee.
- If requesting a Fee Waiver, must submit documentation of need from a financial aid advisor at your current school. This can be uploaded in our Applicant Information System, AIS.
- Essay topic B is required Non-degree Statement of Purpose essay. Explain why enrollment at Texas A&M University is necessary; be sure to indicate the courses that you plan to take and that you understand that admission is for the <u>summer only</u> and you will return to your original institution.
- A complete, official transcript showing high school graduation or the highest and latest collegiate coursework attempted or completed. Must be mailed in a sealed school envelope or submitted electronically from the institution attended.
   See admissions.tamu.edu for acceptable electronic transcript providers

Documents required for enrollment:

- If permanent resident, must submit a copy of both sides
  of the permanent resident card or I-485 prior to
  enrollment. If application is in process please provide
  copy of I-797. If under 18, a copy of the parent's
  permanent resident card is also required.
- If Texas resident based on SB 1528, must submit the SB 1528 affidavit prior to enrollment.
- All students under age 22 entering an institution of higher education (public or private) must provide proof of bacterial meningitis vaccination within the last 5 years. More information is provided on our website, admissions.tamu.edu/meningitis.aspx

### Admission Criteria/Conditions

Complete application files are reviewed and a decision made by the Admissions Selection Committee in collaboration with the academic college.
